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## Вступ

Тести є ефективним інструментом у роботі зі студентами під час вивчення навчальної дисципліни, які дозволяють за короткий проміжок часу перевірити їх знання з конкретної теми та виявити прогалини як у теоретичних знаннях так й в практичних навичках кожного студента індивідуально.

У процесі навчання тести виконують цілу низку функцій, зокрема: контролюючу, навчаючу, розвиваючу, діагностичну та прогностичну.

Навчально-методична розробка складається з 6 частин, які відображають різні явища англійської граматики.

Перша частина посібника вміщує тести по окремим частинам англійської мови, друга – присвячена граматичним часам англійської мови та їх особливостям. У частині 3 подано тести з теми Passive. Тести в частині 4 побудовані на закріплення умовних речень, які представляють собою одну з найскладніших тем англійської граматики. Феноменом в англійській мові є утворення непрямої мови, і тести на даний матеріал розташовані в частині 5. Частина 6 вміщує тести на повторення всього вивченого матеріалу.

Тести з англійської граматики призначено для закріплення, повторення або перевірки знань з англійської граматики. Їх можна використовувати як на аудиторних заняттях, так й у якості домашнього завдання чи самостійної роботи.

Навчально-методичний посібник побудовано таким чином, що кожен тест можна використовувати окремо, в залежності від потреби.

Посібник має практичне значення і призначений для використання на практичних заняттях (або самостійно) з дисципліни „Англійська мова ” для студентів із рівнем знання англійської мови A2-B1; та також для підготовки до ЗНО.
